Celebrating 35 Years: A Legacy of *Transformation*

Where it All Began

In the summer of 1989, 60 youth and adults came together for a 10-day intensive retreat. Teens shared their struggles and the changes they hoped to make before being matched with adult mentors who could help them do it.

What followed was a profound transformation. Youth facing abuse, homelessness, and addiction—many without a support system—began forging new paths. They gained confidence, built stronger relationships, graduated high school, and pursued college and careers.

This retreat marked the beginning of New Pathways of Youth—the first step in a 35-year journey of transforming the lives of youth.



1989

First 10-day intensive retreat for teens is held, 40 mentors and youth attend



1995

A local grantor funds the purchase of the first NPFY headquarters



2008-2015

NPFY acquires 2 mentoring programs and doubles our youth services



2018

NPFY refines its program scalability and replicability to other high-need neighborhoods in Phoenix



2020

NPFY moves into its new headquarters to serve more youth and double its impact



2023

NPFY debuts Level Up, a name for its signature teen program, and Level Up Academy, expanding its curriculum into schools. 2023 also marks the first edition of the Level Up Scholarships



2024

NPFY expands its Level Up Scholarships, benefiting 28 first generation high school graduates.

Level Up Academy

In 2023, we launched **Level Up Academy**, bringing our curriculum into schools for the very first time. During this 10-week, on-campus course, **75 teens learned essential skills** and mindsets that set them up for success in high school and beyond, including:



Goal Setting



Time Management



Stress Management





Self-Directed Learning



Cox Innovation Lab

This year, we opened the Cox Innovation Lab, giving youth a space to explore technology, develop new skills, and connect with their peers.

The lab provides:

- Hands-on learning in design and digital tools like Adobe Creative Suite
- A collaborative place for students to work on projects, play games, create music and audio content, and build relationships
- A foundation for future careers in tech, construction, and creative media



Scholarships

We awarded \$84,000 in scholarships to 28 highly deserving students to fund their education at universities, colleges, and trade schools.

These scholarships cover tuition and essential expenses so that these students—many the first in their families to attend college—have the support they need to reach their full potential.






Thanks to your generosity, NPFY had a strong financial year in 2024, raising nearly \$4M to directly support life-changing programs for youth and their families.

- Culture & Community—Building a network of mentors, partners, and supporters who make our mission possible.


